

Notice of Public Workshop #2

Big Creek Watershed Plan

The Town of Amherstburg, Essex Region Conservation Authority and its partners are developing a watershed plan for the Big Creek watershed. The intent of the Plan is to characterize existing environmental conditions throughout the watershed, and make recommendations for their protection and improvement. This Public Workshop is the second in a series that will provide information about the process, and ensure that the community's interests are reflected in the plan.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide an update on the preliminary results of the technical studies of the Big Creek Watershed that have been ongoing during 2009 and to discuss the direction of the Watershed Plan which will be developed during 2010. Your comments and information gained through this workshop will be used to help the study team focus and address watershed issues and develop strategies to protect and enhance the watershed.
